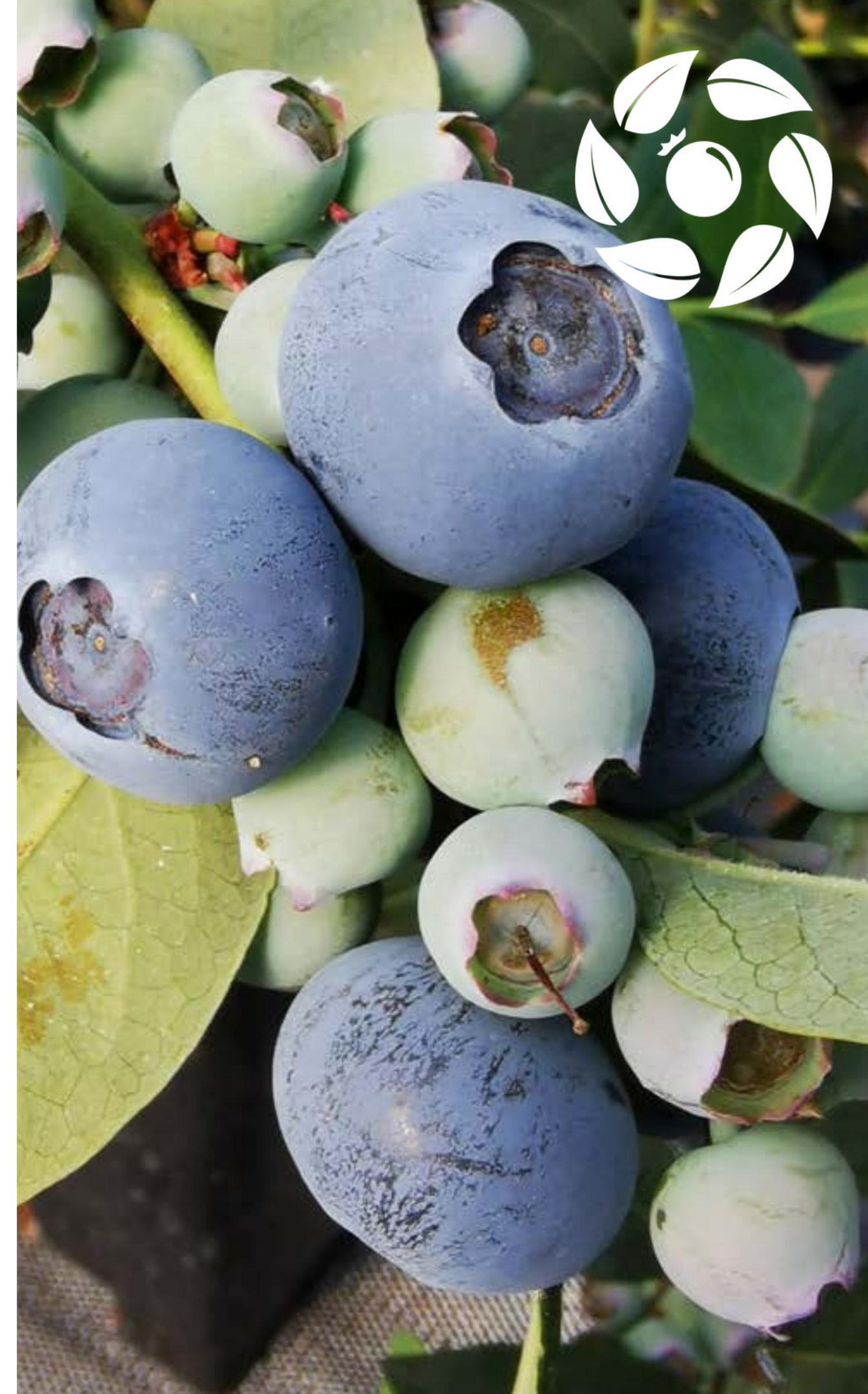

Background -

Gladiator firmly deserves its status as part of the "Blue Angels" series of blueberries. Gladiator was bred at the University of Georgia USA by Dr Scott NeSmith. Gladiator was continually outstanding in the blueberry trials, proving to be a great early to mid-season variety. The plants of Gladiator are upright and vigorous with good disease resistance producing great quality, well displayed fruit.

The fruit -

Gladiator blueberry ripens just after Georgia - 1797 producing excellent crisp, sweet berries with a high Brix and average acidity. The eating quality is consistently very good. The berries of Gladiator are round in shape averaging 14 – 22mm in diameter with the majority of the crop falling into the 17- 19 category. The colour of Gladiator is medium to light blue with an exceptional bloom. The berries of Gladiator blueberry are very firm with a great shelf life.
