GLEN CARRON BENEFITS

- **High percentages of Class 1 fruit (93.3% marketability)**
- **Offers large and consistent fruit sizes. Mean berry: 5.3g, largest fruits 6.3g**

Formerly known as advanced selection 0485K-1, Glen Carron is the latest variety to be released from the James Hutton Limited raspberry breeding programme. Glen Carron was launched in 2018 having been identified as a promising floricane type in 2010. Promoted as a specialist early variety, typically producing high percentages of class 1 fruit with both distinct sweet flavours and striking 6g+ fruits. From a commercial grower perspective, the hairy canes that produce the sweet-tasting, beauty also offer up excellent resistance to cane diseases. Glen Carron yields a high proportion of Class I fruit which, alongside good shipping and fantastic shelf-life, will contribute to reducing food waste.

Agronomy -

Season: Early/Mid

Cropping Period: Early July - Early August

Picking Duration: 4 weeks

Chill Requirement: Min. 1200 hours

Cultivation -

Suitable for open field, soil-grown, or substrate. Aim for 10,000 plants per Ha. 60cm short cane, 40cm long cane

High root and cane vigour produces a high number of canes that display fruit well on strong laterals
